Subj: TRAFFIC COURT FOR THE ADJUDICATION OF ARMED FORCES  
TRAFFIC TICKETS



1. Purpose. To promulgate procedures for processing Armed Forces traffic tickets using reference (a).
2. Cancellation. NTCGLAKESINST 11200.2.
3. Scope. The provisions of this instruction will apply to all persons issued Armed Forces traffic tickets, DD 1408, on board Naval Training Center (NTC), Great Lakes, Illinois. The NTC Complex encompasses all roads and real estate property situated within the boundaries of NTC, Recruit Training Command, Service School Command, Naval Hospital, all family housing at Forrestal, Halsey, and Nimitz Villages, the NTC Golf Course, Building 3200, and adjacent warehouses, Building 3400, Burkey Mall, and all real estate owned, leased, or controlled by the U. S. government in contiguous proximity to one or more of these areas, exclusive of the Veterans Administration Hospital, North Chicago.
4. Information
  - a. Traffic court will be conducted Wednesday (excluding Federal Holidays) from 1300 - 1500 at Building 130. The presiding official will adjudicate Armed Forces traffic citations; and may, if necessary, administratively suspend or revoke driving privileges and motor vehicle registrations on board NTC in accordance with references (a) and (b).
  - b. Personnel receiving Armed Forces traffic tickets are required to appear in traffic court, in accordance with instructions printed on the citation (DD 1408).
  - c. Failure to appear for traffic court within the time period (normally 14 days) prescribed on the citation will result in an automatic plea of guilty being entered on the driving record with the appropriate number of points and/or penalties.
5. Procedures: Authorized personnel issuing an Armed Forces traffic ticket, DD 1408, will ensure the pink and yellow copies of the citation clearly state the date of violation, date and

time period in which to appear and location for the court. The pink copy will be issued to the violator and the white and yellow copies will be turned over to the court clerk.

6. Responsibility. The court judge is responsible for preparing all tickets, recording all entries of findings, maintaining cross-reference files, and forwarding letters of suspension to the next duty station when service members are transferred.
