Subj: FACILITY RESPONSE AND EMERGENCY ACTION PLANS

Ref: (a) Oil Pollution Act of 1990 (OPA-90)

1. Purpose. To promulgate and establish local procedures to combat spills exceeding local capabilities at Naval Training Center (NTC), Great Lakes Complex².

2. Background. The Navy has historically used a two level response planning concept to provide for prompt initial response at the facility level, backed by additional regional resources to combat spills exceeding local capabilities.

3. Policy. Per reference (a), the Navy will continue to use a tiered response and planning strategy. NTC Facility Response and Emergency Action Plans of enclosure (1) address response resources necessary to respond to spills up to the worst case discharge volume at NTC Great Lakes Complex²

4. Action. Actions required to implement NTC Facility Response and Emergency Action plans for NTC Great Lakes Complex² are detailed in enclosure (1).
