Subj: CHILD DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM INSPECTIONS

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 1700.9D  
(b) Military Child Care Act of 1989

1. Purpose. To establish a local multidisciplinary inspection team with expertise in the areas of fire/safety, family advocacy and health/sanitation. This team will inspect the Child Development Program as required by references (a) and (b).

2. Cancellation. NTCGLAKESINST 5040.2A

3. Background. Reference (b) includes a requirement that childcare programs be inspected four times each year. Three of these inspections are to be done locally. Higher headquarters personnel will do the fourth. A team appointed by the Commander, Naval Training Center (NTC), will do one of the local inspections. A representative from the Parent Advisory Board and a Child Development Program Administrator (CDPA) from another installation may be included with this team.


4. Action

a. Assistant Chief of Staff, Base Operations will serve as the inspection team leader.

b. NTC Safety, Great Lakes Fire Department, Fleet and Family Support Center, Family Advocacy and Naval Hospital Preventive Medicine Unit will each provide one representative for the inspection team.

c. Morale, Welfare and Recreation (MWR) Department will appoint a member of the Parent Advisory Board and a CDPA from another installation to be on the inspection team.

d. Findings of the inspection team will be forwarded to the Commander, Naval Training Center and a letter confirming compliance will be forwarded to Commander, Navy Personnel Command (Pers-65) via the chain of command.
