1. Purpose. To provide policy guidance to facilitate coordination of logistics and mobilization support efforts for Naval Training Center (NTC), Great Lakes.

2. Cancellation. NTCGLAKESINST 4080.1B. This instruction has been substantially revised and should be reviewed in its entirety.

3. Information

a. This document consolidates logistics support and mobilization plans for NTC Great Lakes staff, Service School Command (SSC), Recruit Training Command (RTC), Transient Personnel Unit (TPU), and Personnel Support Activity (PSA).

b. Appropriate and essential requirements from reference (a) have been localized to provide only that information applicable to NTC Great Lakes.

c. The NTC Great Lakes LSMP is effective for planning purposes upon receipt. This document is neither the directive nor the authority to procure or stockpile additional material for contingency and wartime conditions.

d. The NTC Staff point of contact for the development and implementation of mobilization plans and programs is the Staff Plans Officer (N34), DSN 792-2752.

4. Action. Action addresses shall:

a. Be familiar with the provisions of this directive, applicable references, and later revisions. Ensure compliance with these documents and all supplemental information or guidance provided.

MOBILIZATION PLANS AND POLICIES

1. Mobilization. The process by which the Armed Forces or part of them are brought to a state of readiness for war or other national emergencies. This includes assembling and organizing personnel, supplies, and material for active military service.
2. M-Day. The day mobilization begins as directed by the Secretary of Defense (SECDEF), based on a decision by Congress or the President.
3. F-Hour. The hour on M-Day that mobilization begins.
4. D-Day. The day hostilities begin.
5. C-Day. The day deployment of forces begin.
6. Periods of Time. A period of time is indicated as follows: Month M+1 means the month (30 days) beginning one (1) month after M-Day, etc.
7. Mobilization Options
 - a. Selective Mobilization. Expansion of the active Navy by mobilization of Naval Reserve Units and/or individual reservists by authority of Congress or the President to satisfy an emergency requirement (for a force tailored to meet a specific requirement, that does not involve a threat to the national security; e.g., mobilization for domestic emergencies such as natural disasters, to protect federal property, or to prevent disruption of federal activities).
 - b. Presidential Selected Reserve Call-Up Authority. Expansion of the Armed Forces, other than during war or national emergency, with up to 200,000 Ready Reservists for a period not to exceed 270 days.
 - c. Partial Mobilization. Mobilization by the President of not more than 1,000,000 Ready Reservists (units and individual reservists) for not longer than 24 months, and the resources needed for the support to meet the requirements of war or other national emergency involving an external threat to the national security (see Title 10, United States Code, Section 673).

d. Full Mobilization. Expansion of the active Navy as a result from actions by Congress and the President to mobilize all units in the existing approved total force structure, and all individual reservists, and the material resources needed for support of the total force. (Full Mobilization will be completed 3 months after M-Day (M+3).)

e. Total Mobilization. Expansion of the Active Navy by organizing or activating additional units beyond the existing capability of existing force levels and the mobilization of all national resources needed to create and sustain such forces.

8. Surge Courses. Surge courses are courses that require a sudden dramatic increase in the number of students/trainees to meet the stated demand during full or total mobilization. Annex K pertains.

9. Mobilization Period (MP). For CNTC activities planning purposes, the Mobilization Period (M-Day through M-6) will be projected as being the first 6 months of the current fiscal year (CFY) or CFY +1.

10. Mobilization Workweek. The mobilization workweek during the first and second months following M-Day will be extended to at least 60 hours for activities having a normal peacetime workweek of 40 hours. The mobilization workweek during the third and subsequent months following M-Day will be extended to at least 48 hours for activities having a normal peacetime workweek of 40 hours. The peacetime course length may be reduced by a factor of 17 upon mobilization, based on a student/trainee 48 hour work week. Double or triple shifting by a command is allowed as much as facilities, equipment, manpower, and base support will allow.

11. Mobilization Workload. An objective appraisal must be made of the activities' capacities to absorb additional personnel.

12. Mobilization Curriculum. Curriculum that is shortened due to mobilization must be closely examined. Identify in enclosure (1), all courses taught at your command. List the Course Identification Number (CIN), Course Title, peacetime course length, and mobilization course length. When determining mobilization course length, identify the course as (a) SELF-PACED: Instruction where each student works through the

instructional material at his\her own pace, (b) GROUP PACED: Instruction developed in a sequence and paced to suit the progress of the majority.

13. Canceled Courses. Students/trainees for courses, which Chief of Naval Operations (CNO) has identified as being canceled upon mobilization, will be made available for transfer no later than 15 days following M-Day. Supporting personnel no longer required because of course cancellation will be eligible for transfer by M+1. Courses canceled by CNO will not be continued for non-Navy personnel. When practical, courses will be continued until completion, and all personnel will be transferred. Annex J pertains.
14. Contractor Managed/Supported Courses. These courses will continue to be managed/supported during the mobilization period.
15. Peak Class Inputs. Unless otherwise shown in Annex K, these non-surge courses during the mobilization period should not exceed peacetime support requirements.
16. Class "A" (Initial Skill Training) Courses. (Not applicable.)
 - a. Other Than Canceled and Surge Class "A" Courses. (Not applicable.)
 - b. Surge Class "A" Courses
 - (1) Special Personnel. The proportion of the Class input/output for the surge class "A" courses identified in Annex K for special personnel (Nuclear, Submarine, and 6YOs) during the mobilization period should be projected the same as the CFY.
 - (2) Non-Navy Student/Trainee. The class input-output required for surge class "A" courses for non-Navy personnel during the mobilization period should be projected the same as the CFY.
 - (3) Trained Manpower Required. Annex K identifies the time-phased and total M-Day through M + 180 days additive estimates of class "A" course trained Navy manpower required which may not be available from other sources. The outputs required for surge class "C" courses must be considered part of

the proposed surge class "A" course initial training manpower rating output.

17. Class "C" (Skill Progression Training). (Not applicable).

a. Other Than Canceled and Surge Class "C" Courses (Not applicable.)

b. Surge Class "C" Courses

(1) Applicable Courses (Not applicable.)

18. Class "E" (Professional Development) Courses. (Not applicable.)

19. Class "F" (Functional Training) Courses. (Not applicable.)

20. Class "P" (Officer Acquisition Training) Courses. (Not applicable.)

21. Class "R" (Recruit) Courses.

a. Class "R" courses are surge courses. Commencing with M+1, Great Lakes' maximum recruit berthing capacity is 23,400. This capacity is based on full wartime utilization of the peacetime class "R" and apprentice training (class "AA") berthing facilities. RTC will operate on a 5.8 week schedule.

b. The Basic Military Training (BMT) mobilization curriculum will be implemented on M-Day; BMT course length will be reduced by 25 percent to approximately 41 days based on the modified curriculum and the increased work week. (The BMT mobilization curriculum includes provisions for increased damage control, firefighting, and survival training.)

c. Apprentice training will be canceled on M-Day and associated material, facilities, manpower, and other resources will be made available to support the increased requirements for Class "R" training.

d. Percentage allocations of BMT, NAVET, and OSVET personnel will parallel peacetime. OSVET personnel who have been out of the service for less than 4 years will be sent to RTC, Great Lakes. OSVET personnel out of the service more than 4 years will

be assigned to RTC and they will continue to be BMT trainees, but may be accelerated at the discretion of RTC.

e. Annex K identifies the projected time-phased and total (M-Day through M+180 days) outputs from Class "R" courses.

20. NAMMOS

a. The Navy Manpower Mobilization System (NAMMOS) is a computer assisted, macro-level management information process designed to give scenario-dependent mobilization manpower requirements, to assess the ability of the personnel system to meet those requirements, and to successfully defend the need for manpower during annual reviews and resources allocation proceedings.

b. NAMMOS states: Any billet that does not require a military member must be civilian.

c. Subordinate commands will submit Manpower Change Request (OPNAV Form 1000/4A's) to CNTC GLAKES (Code T01M) to input recommended military quantitative and qualitative mobilization data for inclusion in subsequent Manpower Authorizations (OPNAV Form 1000/2) and the Navy Manpower Data Accounting System (NMDAS) database.

d. Additional guidance for NAMMOS maintenance is defined in reference (a).

21. Annexes. For most LSMP users, the information contained in the annexes will be adequate for planning and information purposes. LSMP users requiring more current or detailed information to assist logistics support efforts for the activities must take action to get the specific required information from the responsible activity.

a. Annex A - Organizational Chart. Organization charts and reporting relationships are delineated in applicable command Standard Organization and Regulations Manual (SORM).

b. Annex B - Establishment Instructions. Lists the authority establishing NTC and major tenant commands.

- o. Annex O - (Staff Sea/Shore Rotation Billets). Provides the relevant Unit Identification Code (UIC), Billet Sequence Code (BSC), billet title, responsible code, and incumbent code (BCG) for staff military billets with a Functional Area Code (FAC) of "G" or "L."
- p. Annex P - (Staff Peacetime Only Billets). Lists the relevant UIC, BSC, billet title, responsible code, and incumbent data for staff military billets, if any, which are peacetime-only billets.
- q. Annex O - (Staff Mobilization Only Billets). Lists the relevant, UIC, BSC, billet title, responsible code for staff military billets, if any, which are mobilization-only billets.

r. Annex R - (Staff Ready Reserve/Guard Personnel). Lists the relevant UIC, position description/job number, position title, responsible code, and incumbent data for staff civilian positions that are filled by Ready Reserve/Guard personnel. Staff Ready Reserve/Guard personnel would probably be transferred during the first two weeks following M-Day. These personnel may be considered immediately available for recall. These personnel may not be deferred or exempted from mobilization because of civilian occupations.

s. Annex S - (Staff Military Retirees). Lists the relevant UIC, position description/job number, position title, responsible code, and incumbent data for staff civilian positions that are filled by non-disabled military retirees under the age of 60. Plans for full mobilization must assume non-disabled military retirees under the age of 60 will not be available as civilian employees after M-Day.

t. Annex T - (Probable Sequence of Events and Responses). Provides an outline showing the probable sequence of events (and responses) resulting from a simulated or actual mobilization.

u. Annex U - (Sample Correspondence). Provides examples of possible correspondence in response to or in anticipation of a simulated/actual mobilization.

v. Annex V - Not required.

w. Annex W - (Ready Reserve Screening). Provides the letter format and list of military centers where Reserve screening determination requests will be sent. Commands with Ready Reserve civilian employees must periodically screen these employees to ensure they are considered vital to the nation's defense efforts in their civilian jobs and shouldn't be mobilized in the Armed Forces in an emergency.

These billets are managed by CNO to provide for sea/shore rotation for deprived ratings. These billets require only a military skill indicated by the paygrade. Accordingly, incumbents may be transferred to fill a mobilization rating billet shortage. The billet could remain gapped until backfilled by a reservist or someone with a less critical rating.

ANNEX T TO NTCGLAKES LSMPPROBABLE SEQUENCE OF EVENTS (AND RESPONSES) RESULTINGFROM A SIMULATED/ACTUAL MOBILIZATION

1. NTC will receive a message from CNO announcing that a Full Mobilization has been declared by the Secretary of Defense, based on a decision by the Congress/of the President. This message and all applicable subsequent correspondence will include appropriate CNET third-echelon activities as action/information addresses, or if not, Code N-322, or another member of CNET Staff, will draft a readdressal to these activities. Amplifying guidance for CNET Staff and third-echelon activities will be drafted by those CNET Headquarters personnel who act for CNET in the applicable areas during peacetime.
2. The following guidance will probably be provided at this time, or shortly thereafter:
 - a. Required funding/diversion of funds will be authorized as necessary to accomplish the mobilization mission. CNET (Code N-6) will develop requirements, monitor/coordinate, and keep all concerned informed.
 - b. All personnel will be extended on active duty for a minimum of one year from M-Day (Mobilization Day).
 - c. Navy rotation of personnel will be terminated.
 - d. Leave associated with PCS (Permanent Change of Station) orders will be minimized. [Three days for M-Day through M+6 (M-Day plus 6 months) and 6 days from M+6 through M+12 (M-Day plus 12 months)].
 - e. Functional Area Code (FAC) G and H personnel will be reassigned at M-Day (i.e., billets which are identified in the OPNAV Manpower Authorization as required for sea/shore rotation). The empty billets will be gapped until personnel in noncritical skill areas can be ordered as replacements.
3. Certain personnel procedures will be in effect at mobilization. These include, but may not be limited to, the following:

MAY 12 1999

a. Civilian positions may be temporarily filled by military for reasons of recruit or immediate fill. Military billets may be filled by civilian personnel. Civilian manpower ceiling will be canceled upon mobilization.

b. Retired personnel, fleet reservists, and other inactive reservists will be used to fill billets in shore activities for which they are qualified and to fill appropriate billets afloat and on foreign stations if they are physically qualified.

c. Civilians assigned to Leadership and Management Education and Training (LMET) and Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) will be reassigned upon mobilization for additional duty, where required, to positions vacated by Ready Reserve and Retired Military personnel.

d. Military personnel assigned to LMET and EEO billets will be reassigned upon mobilization for additional duty to gapped military billets, pending their transfer. (These billets should be peacetime billets.)

e. Shortfalls of skills, not available in the active reserve forces, will be filled by volunteer veterans, direct procurement of related civilian skills, and Navy training of civilian volunteers and personnel provided by the recruiting command and selective service.

f. The U. S. Coast Guard will be assigned military functions by the CNO. However, the Commandant of the Coast Guard will be responsible for procurement, assignment, and discipline of all military and civilian personnel of the Coast Guard throughout the mobilization(s).

g. Selective Reserve personnel will commence reporting to applicable NAVEDTRACOM activities within 48-hours of F-Hour. The remaining Ready Reserve personnel will report to previously designated billets not later than 2 weeks following M-Day. Superiors in command of NAVEDTRACOM activities may redistribute these personnel and other assigned personnel to more critical billets at their activities.

h. All civilian positions filled by Ready Reserve personnel at NAVEDTRACOM activities will be gapped pending recruitment of replacement civilian personnel. In addition, all civilian positions filled by retired military who are under the age of 60

and otherwise physically qualified may be gapped pending the recruitment of replacement civilian personnel. The redistribution of personnel with the NAVEDTRACOM activities and the increased mobilization workweek should reduce the impact to the CNET mission as a result of the gapping of these billets.

i. The M+1 (M-Day plus 1 month) column of the OPNAV Manpower Authorization for each activity will be the current authorization upon mobilization. However, full mobilization may not be completed until M+3 (M-Day plus 3 months) for support activities. Accordingly, most gapped an "other unfilled" during the period of M+1 through M+3. In view of the above, the mobilization workweek will be adjusted on a case-by-case basis for NAVEDTRACOM personnel. (For these activities whose normal workweek is 40 hours, the NAVEDTRACOM mobilization workweek during the first and second month following M-Day will be extended to 60 hours; e.g., 10 hours per day, 6 days a week. The NAVEDTRACOM mobilization work-week during the third and subsequent months following M-Day will be extended to 48 hours.)

4. The mobilization workweek will result in students/trainees completing courses about 17 percent earlier than during peacetime. (The Catalog of Navy Training Courses (CANTRAC) and the Navy Integrated Training Resources Administration System (NITRAS) indicate mobilization course lengths. These course lengths are based either on a course-by-course review or CNET's Mobilization Course Length Guide, Annex X. The guide is based on the anticipated mobilization workweek during M+3 through M+12.)

5. Courses listed in Annex J, which OPNAV has identified as being canceled upon mobilization, will in fact be canceled upon mobilization. However, for planning purposes, it should be assumed that (1) no additional personnel will be enrolled after M-Day, and (2) those personnel who are enrolled may be allowed to finish if adequate resources are available for their instruction and berthing. Students enrolled in courses which are canceled may, in fact, be transferred immediately following M-Day, and supporting staff/instructor personnel may be transferred not later than M+2. (Annex D provides an example of a message which advises NAVEDTRACOM activities of mobilization and courses canceled upon mobilization(s).)

6. OPNAV, Fleet Commanders, and TYCOM's will periodically provide or request information regarding modified mobilization student workloads for applicable courses. The NAVEDTRACOM will respond as appropriate.

7. Student loads for other than U. S. Navy personnel (e.g., foreign and other service) will not exceed that projected for peacetime. However, student loads for courses canceled upon mobilization will be reduced to zero.

8. Recruit training accessions will be as set forth in OPNAV guidance, CNET's LSMP, and as updated by the CNO following M-Day. Recruit training will immediately increase its throughput by increasing input and reducing course length by 25 percent. (Average course reduction will be from about 8 weeks to about 6 weeks.) Reduction will be achieved by working 10-12 curriculum hour days at 6 days per week. Damage Control, Firefighting, Small Arms, and Survival Training will be increased. The mobilization curriculum so indicates. Apprentice Training will be eliminated and resources made available for recruit training. Peacetime habitability plans will also consider male/female segregation. It is possible to train more females, but only at the expense of male training. Wartime habitability standards are 50 square feet per recruit. Full wartime utilization space is assumed. Code N-211 will monitor/coordinate for CNET HQ and develop additional amplifying guidance for CNTECHTRA as required.

9. Professional development will be phased out upon mobilization. As a minimum, no new entrants will be programmed after M-Day for most professional development programs. CNET (Code N-02) will monitor/coordinate professional development education for CNET HQ and develop additional amplifying guidance, as required, for programs under the cognizance of N-02.

10. Officer acquisition training will be modified to permit commissioning immediately for first-class midshipmen, and upon completion of their second-class year for second-class midshipmen. Officer candidate course length will be reduced to approximately 14 weeks. CNET (Code N-02) will monitor/coordinate officer acquisition training for CNET HQ and develop additional amplifying guidance, as required, for programs under the cognizance of N-02.

11. Aviation Reserve Officer Candidate program will graduate people already in the pipeline as rapidly as possible. Further inputs for flight training will be procured directly from colleges and universities, probably through a modified Aviation Officer Candidate Program. CNET (Code N-4) will monitor/coordinate for CNET HQ and develop additional amplifying guidance, as required, for CNATRA.

12. Flight training lead time necessary to produce a Pilot or Naval Flight Officer (NFO) is not compatible with the duration of the warfare scenario. DOD guidance dictates that there will be no additional aircraft made available for the projected 180-day scenario. Thus, the planned numbers of student pilots and NFOs entering the active inventory represent only a slight surge or increase in the peacetime projection, as a result of increased workweek and reduced attrition, within the constraints of available training aircraft and facilities. CNET (Code N-4) will monitor/coordinate for CNET HQ and develop additional amplifying guidance, as required, for CNATRA.

13. Specialized skill training will be altered based on anticipated requirements for wartime and on the actual attrition rates, in part, as a result of mobilization incidents/hostilities. In general, this training would probably surge to provide graduates, as rapidly as possible, for deploying and transition units, intermediate maintenance activities, base expansions, and casualty replacement.
